What is Title I?

The Kindezi School is identified as a Title I school as part of Every Student Succeed Act of 2017 (ESSA). Title I is a federal program that provides funding to local school districts to help ensure that all children in district Title I schools meet the state's high academic standards.

Title I programs must be based on effective means of improving student achievement and including strategies to support parent and family engagement. All Title I schools must jointly develop a written parent and family engagement plan with all parents and families.

What is it?

This is a plan that describes how The Kindezi School West will provide opportunities to improve family engagement to support student learning. The Kindezi School West values the contributions and involvement of parents to establish an equal partnership for the common goal of improving student achievement. This plan describes the different ways that The Kindezi School West will support parent engagement and how parents can help plan and participate in activities and events to promote student learning at school and at home.

How is it developed?

The Kindezi School West invites all parents to attend our Title I Parental Engagement Input meeting to review and revise this Parent and Family Engagement Plan, our School-Parent Compact and the parental engagement budget. Additionally, parent input and comments regarding this plan are welcome during the school year. The plan is sent home with each student by October 31st. It is available in the Parent Resource Room, electronically through school website and Parent Square for parents to view and submit feedback throughout the year. All parent feedback received during the year will be used to revise the plan for the next school year. We also distribute an annual survey online to ask parents for their suggestions on the plan and the use of funds for parental involvement. Parents can also give feedback during parent meetings and activities during the school year.

Who is it for?

All students participating in the Title I, Part A program, and their families, are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. The Kindezi School West will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents with limited English, parents with disabilities and parents of migratory children.

Where is it available?

The plan is distributed in hardcopy with each student, and distributed at the Annual Title I meeting. Parents can also retrieve a copy in the Parent Resource Room and electronically.

The Kindezi School West 2019-2020 Goals

Literacy: The number of beginning level students will decrease by 50% and the number of proficient level and distinguished level students will increase by 20%. This goal will be supported by providing additional academic resources and assignments to improve critical thinking skills, processing, analyzing, research and expression that focus on fluency, comprehension, and phonics.



School-Parent Compact

As part of this plan, The Kindezi School West and our families will develop a school-parent compact. It is an agreement that explains how parents, teachers and students work together to make sure all our students reach grade-level standards.

The compact is reviewed and updated annually based on feedback from parents, students and teachers during the Title I Parent Engagement Input meeting. A copy of the school-parent compact brochure is distributed to every family to use during the year.

Kindezi Parents Let's Get Together!

The Kindezi School West will host the following events to build the capacity for strong parent and family engagement to support a partnership among the school, parents, and the community to improve student academic achievement.

- **Curriculum Night – August 2019**

- **Principal's Café – (September 2019 – April 2020)**
Gain knowledge about topics relevant to your child's education and engage directly with school leadership.
- **Annual Title I Meeting – October 2019**

Invitations will be sent home with scholars, sent via parent square, posted on the school's webpage.

A forum for parents to participate in roundtable discussions with the principal and staff regarding the school wide plan, parental involvement policy, school-parent compacts and the parental involvement budget.
- **Chat and Chew– Quarterly**
Learn how Kindezi is growing. Topics include bullying, navigating Kindezi, technology safety, and more...
- **Grade level transition for Parents (as needed)**

We will take the following measures to promote and support parents as an important foundation of the school in order to strengthen the school and reach our school goals.

We will:

- Ensure that all information related to school and parent programs, meetings, and other activities is published in English and Spanish, posted on the school web site, and parent square for all parents.
- Provide trainings for staff during their planning periods and staff meetings on strategies to improve communication with parents and ideas to increase family engagement. Staff will also share best practices during regularly scheduled professional development sessions.

- Post meeting minutes/information online within 48 hours following events.
- Stream meetings periodically online throughout the school year to engage all families.
